Foreword:

From PC Alex Clarke;

I have had a concern raised in respect of speeding in Union Street, Stenhousemuir. The area has been monitored however is unsuitable for hand held radar detection. The narrow parking has exacerbated issues there.

Further speeding issues on Stirling Road, Larbert near to the ambulance entrance after 6pm. Hand held radar has been completed and several drivers warned. This shall continue.

Inconsiderate parking and speeding at Graham Avenue, Larbert has also been reported, mainly due to the playgroup building and club nearby. Checks have been made when possible however nothing untoward found as yet.

We have been passed the 'dip' near the Gulf petrol station in Larbert for concerns raised about boy racers around midnight but nothing has been observed.

On the 10<sup>th</sup> of this month Police traced a 34 year old male who had attempted to break into three houses in the Stenhousemuir and Larbert areas. This individual was caught in the early hours and appeared at Falkirk Sheriff court.

A serious assault was reported at Stenhousemuir Bowling Club on the 7<sup>th</sup> of this month and a 28 year old female has been apprehended in relation to this and the matter concluded.

On the 19<sup>th</sup> of this month, following a concern report for a young female Police had cause to speak with a 14 year old female at Asda in Stenhousemuir. This female thereafter lashed out and kicked/bit Police officers. She is subject of a report to the children's reporter.
